Setting The Record Straight

Q. What do you like best about the United States?

A. The space, freedom, sunshine and the supermarkets. Q. Do you wear glasses?

Q. What is the significance of the pinky ring you wear?

A. It's a Russian wedding ring. I bought one for Cassie a few years back and later on, she bought one for me. We each have one now.

Q. What size shirt do you wear?

A. 15½ long.

Q. How do you like being compared to Cary Grant?

A. I'm flattered, but it is really Remington Steele that people are comparing to Cary Grant, not me.

Q. Can you tell us anything about the next season of "Remington Steele"?

A. As yet, I've not read the new scripts, but I do know that one of the writers from "The Avengers", Brian Clement, will write three episodes which should give the series an English flavor.

Q. The second season had far more action-packed scripts than the first season. Do you prefer action or detective deduction?

A. I prefer the more adult scripts, but I like a mixture of both.

Q. How do your children feel about the success of "Remington Steele"?

A. They're happy because they will have another year in school.

Q. Do you do your own stunts on "Remington Steele"?

A. As much as possible, yes, I do...within reason. I do all the fight scenes and I did do the fire-eating scene because I can do that.

Q. What makes life meaningful?

A. Children.

Q. Will "Remington Steele" be filmed outside of the United States this season?

A. Yes. During the Olympics this summer, we plan on traveling to Europe to film four episodes. We will do one in Ireland, one in London, one in Malta and one in the South of France. We will be gone for approximately six or seven weeks. I'm looking forward to it.

Q. Did Charlotte and Christopher have cameo appearances in the episode filmed in Alpulco?

A. Yes, they walked through a scene or two.

Q. If "Remington Steele" was cancelled, would you return to England to live?

A. No, I would stay here in the United States. I like it here very much, and so does my family.

Q. Who painted the portrait of Cassie for "Woman of Steele"?

A. I have no idea. We have the portrait now though.

Q. How long does it take to film an episode of "Remington Steele"?

A. About seven working days on the average.

Q. Does your family enjoy "Remington Steele"? Do they watch the show when it's televised?

A. They enjoy the show, yes. The first season, they watched it avidly, now less and less. I taped all of the first season episodes, but I don't anymore.

Q. Do you choose and coordinate your own clothes?

A. Yes, I get to choose my clothes to a degree.

Q. Do you get to keep your wardrobe from "Remington Steele"?

A. Unofficially, yes, the clothes go into my own wardrobe. Unfortunately, I rarely go anywhere when I can use them. How many suits can you wear? I did get to bring some of the clothes with me when I visited New York recently though.

Q. How much input are you allowed on the scripts for the show?

A. I don't have any input in the first stages. After the script is given to me, I can make suggestions for changes, and they are usually given consideration, but that's about it.

Q. Has Sean ever appeared on "Remington Steele"?

A. No, he hasn't, and I don't suspect he ever will.

Q. Do you like country music? Pop music?

A. Yes, I like country music. I especially like Dolly Parton and Willie Nelson. I enjoy the Top 10 very much, too.

From the Bookshelf...

If you want to keep up with Mr. Steele and his movie trivia, you'll need the right equipment: a comfortable chair, a TV, the late show and a bowl of popcorn. But, sometimes you need help keeping plots, titles, actors, etc., in order. Fortunately, the publishing industry has the following to help you out:

First and foremost is *The Film Buff's Checklist of Motion Pictures* (1912-1979), edited by D. Richard Baer. It lists titles, actors, dates, distributors, and length. It is the most complete list published to date. Its one disadvantage—lack of plot lines—is remedied by book #2: *TV Movies* edited by Leonard Maltin (of "Entertainment Tonight"). It is updated every two years and is more current than the checklist. It provides the plot lines and some interesting bits of trivia. There are a few omissions in this book, and you should ignore the ratings in both books. The above two books list films by title. Another helpful book is *The Film Encyclopedia* by Ephriam Katz. It gives biographies and definitions of actors, directors and film terms. It can be very helpful when you can remember the actor's name but not the title of the film he appeared in.

If your local bookstore doesn't have these in stock, they can order them for you (at a small extra cost, usually). While it's not absolutely necessary for you to have these books, they can really be useful and a lot of fun. Besides, you get a smug feeling of satisfaction when you can name the movie, actors, etc., when Remington does.
